

# WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT OVERDRAFTS AND OVERDRAFT FEES

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices that come with your account.
- 2. We also offer <u>overdraft protection plans</u>, such as a link to a savings account or a Cash Reserve Line of Credit, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

### STANDARD OVERDRAFT PRACTICES

#### What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

## FEES CHARGED IF FNB PAYS AN OVERDRAFT

#### What fees will I be charged if FNB pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a \$35 fee each time we pay an overdraft.
- We will only charge up to 5 overdraft fees per day.
- No overdraft fees will be charged for items that overdraw your account by \$10 or less.
- Also, if your account is overdrawn for 5 or more consecutive business days, we will charge an additional \$5 per business day up to 15 business days.
